The Department of Pathology, Western University, the London Health Sciences Centre, St. Joseph's Health Care and the Middlesex Hospital Alliance is seeking an Anatomical Pathologist for full-time appointment. Applicants should be certified, or eligible for certification, in Anatomical or General Pathology by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada, or equivalent. Candidates must have an MD or equivalent degree, and must be eligible for Licensure by The College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario. Rank will be determined by experience and qualifications at the time of appointment.

This position is aimed at an academically orientated candidate with strong surgical pathology skills. Our pathology service is subspecialized and developed subspecialty interest and expertise in breast, gastrointestinal or hematopathology would be considered an asset, although other areas of expertise will be considered. Participation in frozen section coverage is expected. Appropriate teaching at the undergraduate, graduate or postgraduate level and other academic activities will be expected. Preferences will be given to candidates with an established background of diagnostic expertise and academic activity. The salary and benefit package is competitive and attractive.

The Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine serves London Health Sciences Centre, St. Joseph's Health Care and the Middlesex Hospital Alliance. It is one of the largest departments in Canada, this department has an annual workload of approximately 50,000 surgical specimens, 30,000 cytology specimens and 550 autopsies. The Department of Pathology at Western University has a long history of strength and excellence in many areas of diagnostic service, teaching and research, and has an environment conducive to career and personal development. The Department of Pathology has 37 faculty members and is one of 22 departments in the Schulich School of Medicine & Dentistry (<http://www.schulich.uwo.ca/>).
